Scoop Sort & Pour



1 What you need



A selection of household containers of different sizes and shapes.

A large spoon, ladle or scoop.

Pom poms, cotton balls, pasta or any small items you have.

2 Set up



Place the containers in a basket or on the floor.

Put the small items in a bowl within easy reach of your toddler.

Show them how to scoop, sort and pour!

3 Let them explore



Encourage your toddler to scoop the items and pour them into different containers.

Let them try, repeat and explore.

There's no right or wrong way to play!

4 What it supports



Fine motor skills (grip, scoop, pour)



Hand-eye coordination and focus



Sorting, size awareness and problem-solving
